HOW TO BE IN CONTROL WHEN EVERYTHING IS OUT OF CONTROL

Dear Friend:

If there's ever been a time where you feel out of control-now is likely one of those times! COVID19 has turned everything upside down. I have said it before and I will repeat it: this is not the first worldwide pandemic. The 1918 Spanish flu killed 50 million people. The 1968 Hong Kong flu killed 1 million people.
