GIANT PROMISES

Dear Friend:

I have both read and heard it said that there are over 3,000 promises in the Bible. Wow...that is a lot of promises. I believe my sources and I do not have the time to personally count every promise in the Bible.

Did you know that there are many promises in the Bible regarding God, faith and money? In 2 Corinthians 9:6-11 we find four promises related to giving to God financially. The first promise is: sow generously – reap generously. I call this the “law of sowing and reaping.” It is a fact of the farm – every seed of corn produces more than one ear of corn. Every time we give financially to the Lord’s work he multiplies it and we reap multiple blessings. The second promise in 2 Corinthians 9:6-11 is: give cheerfully – please God completely. Verse 7 says that God loves everyone but what pleases Him regarding our finances is that we give cheerfully not grudgingly. Third promise: give all you should – he will give all you need. Many, many scriptures back this up. Remember God promises to meet our needs, not our greed’s. Fourth promise: you will be made rich so that he will receive thanks. I am not advocating what is known as the prosperity gospel – give to God so you can get from God unlimited money. Give to God and he may choose to bless you in other ways as well. The main purpose God blesses us financially or otherwise is so that it will result in thanks to Him. We tell others how he has blessed us, how we are thankful and he gets the glory. Please do not forget the four giant promises from God in 2 Corinthians 9:6-11.
