HOPE

At the beginning of each year I take some extended prayer and Bible reading time to seek out both a personal and church theme for the year. Out of that theme I look for a key word and try to especially keep that in mind. On January 14th of this year the theme I felt God game me for the church was: GIVE HOPE AND THE JOY OF THE LORD. The theme word was HOPE. At the time I had no idea HOPE would be so critical throughout 2020. On January 14th we heard about some virus in China and pretty much expected it to be "their" problem. The political infighting was focused mostly among the Democrats – we had no idea how strong the fighting could get between the two parties. Peaceful-good protests had not started. Looters and criminal behavior was nowhere on the horizon. The economy was setting all kinds of positive records. Seven months from January 14th it has all changed – so much seems so hopeless!

I heard someone the other day say that COVID-19 is hitting people so hard emotionally even IF they do not have it. Why? Because we cannot see the end of it! Think about it: we know approximately when hurricanes and tornadoes are going to end. We know approximate length of time when most illnesses will end. We even know about how long a recession will last. But COVD-19? We know cases will mostly disappear when a vaccine is found, but no one knows WHEN the vaccine WILL be found. It is the not knowing that can steal our hope.

Christians can have hope in these seemingly hopeless times. The word hope appears about 350 times in the Bible. Most of the time it points to God as our source of hope. The scripture verse connected to the theme word is this: "For I know the plans I have for you declares the Lord, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." (Jeremiah 29:11) Look very closely at the last line: "plans to give you hope and a future." You and I, AND Franklin Church can have hope! It is ours for the receiving! Will you receive it? Hope is defined as: "To desire with expectation of obtainment." We can count on obtaining what God promises in Jeremiah 29:11!
