I noticed after church he used it as people talked to him. He knows maybe 10 English words. He was one of the last ones out of church and when he was leaving, he used Google Translate to say to me: "Thanks for letting me come to your party". The more I thought about it the more he was right. I thought to myself: "If there is one day that is truly a day of celebration/a party it is Easter! Worship for Easter should be a party-like atmosphere. We have the greatest reason in the world to celebrate.

We serve a risen Savior, he's in the world today and I know that he is living whatever men may say. He lives, He lives, Christ Jesus lives today...let's party/celebrate!
